Mr. Kelley's work on behalf of Papa John Schnatter, the Founder of Papa John's International, Inc., demonstrates his ability to represent, advise and defend multiple (and simultaneous) legal, regulatory and public relations battles across multiple jurisdictions:

- Lead counsel for all litigation and the trial in Delaware Chancery Court in the matter Schnatter v. Papa John's International, Inc., C.A. No. 2018-0542-AGB (Del. Ch.), in which the Chancellor of Delaware ruled that the Board of Directors of Papa John's International and others must give Mr. Schnatter numerous documents, a ruling which came after a full trial on the matter and expanded Delaware law in meaningful ways;
